34. ACCOMMODATION CHANGES-

POINTS FOR DISCUSSION

This JCR notes:

- i) Currently, occupants of Ship Street houses pay the same rent as occupants of the rest of college, including the new Ship Street Centre.
- ii) The rooms in the Ship Street houses, which are mainly occupied by graduates, are much smaller and older than those in most other places in college, and the facilities are much worse.
- iii) Graduates who live in Ship Street Houses feel that they are not getting value for money, especially considering the quality that those in the Ship Street Centre get.

Points for discussion:

- iv) Would the JCR approve of the rent for the rooms in Ship Street houses to be lower than the rent for the rest of the rooms on the main site, which are commonly occupied mostly by first-year undergraduates.

POINTS RAISED:

- Why no distinction between college rooms and Ship Street Centre? Main issue: college has objected to grading rooms in the past, only solution to make it fairer for Ship Street residents
- No grading for freshers whatsoever
- Same issue has been raised over past 3 years, always same conclusion
- JCR subsidising accommodation improvements for MCR? Possibility of MCR doing the same?
- Just try improve quality of Ship Street rooms? Financial constraints
- Past issue: graduates have always just paid the same. Graduates in a better financial position
