This JCR further notes that:

1. The (i) used his annual oration (link attached) this week to propose that the University should be able to charge £16,000 a year in (ii), the notional “full cost” of an Oxford education.
2. A near doubling of (ii) would have disastrous consequences for the work of ensuring Oxford is open to all, with entrance based on ability not wealth.
3. Oxford University already has to work hard to combat an image and reputation as an institution for the rich and privileged and this would set that work back significantly.
4. The (iii) is proposing a motion to the Student Union’s Council proposing that students should oppose such a new policy.
5. Common Room Presidents have agreed to issue a joint statement in opposition to the proposal.

This JCR therefore resolves:

1. To mandate the (iv) to sign the joint statement.
2. To mandate those who represent the JCR at OUSU Council to vote in favour of the (iii)’s motion.

Andrew notes that we are talking on an Oxford scale not a national level. He wants to ask if anyone has anything to say.

Chris asks what this vote is for – Andrew says that the college presidents have all got together to do this and that OUSU is doing something. Tom Rutland says that OUSU have mandate the president to write a letter to the Vice Chancellor

Louis asks what ‘basically implies’ means. Tom notes that the Vice-Chancellor said that students should be paying the true fees and then later notes that it cost around £16000 per student.
